Overview:

Moorsholm Memorial Hall is a community asset used by villagers for its Doctor’s Surgery, various sports including badminton, bowls and yoga, jewelry making and use as a polling station, as well as community events such as weddings, funerals, parties and charity dos.

£4320 was awarded to pay for the removal and replacement of the existing kitchen and entrance hall flooring with a safety non-slip commercial grade product to make events safer and more attractive for guests. These areas have a high volume of footfall and were previously very dangerous in wet weather, previously requiring the use of mats to reduce the possibility of accidents.
